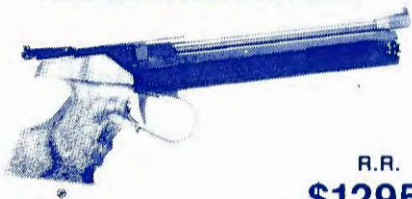

Standard Pistol

Prior to the competition your pistol must be checked in at the gun check for trigger weight (1,000 gram minimum), pistol weight (1,400 gram maximum) and to ensure that the pistol fits the box (300 x 150 x 50mm).

You are permitted ten minutes preparation time prior to the commencement of the match and during this time you may dry fire the pistol.

The course of fire in standard pistol is for five sighting shots in a period of 150 seconds (per series). This is followed by the 20 second stage which is four series of five shots in each 20 seconds. The match is then completed by shooting four series of five shots in ten seconds (per series).

At open competitions your targets are changed at the end of each time section, giving you three new targets for the match. At club level most competitions are shot using one target and patching out after each five or ten shots. It is desirable that the targets are patched after each five shots as, should a malfunction or some other problem occur, it would then be difficult to sort out the problem because of the five previous shots.

Malfunctions

Should you have a malfunction in the 150 second series and you have the time, you may replace the defective round without any assistance from the range officer. This procedure should only be adopted if the malfunction occurs early in the series and not towards the end of the 150 seconds.

The match is split into two sections, one being what is known as the precision stage (150 second series), the other being the timed event (20 and 10 second series).

In the 150 second series you are permitted to have a bench on which the pistol may be rested between each shot, however, once the 150 second series is completed, the bench must be lifted or removed and the 20 and 10 second series are started with the competitor in the ready position (the arm is at 45°).

Backing Targets

At open competitions you will notice that a backing target is used for this match. This is to enable the range officials to determine misplaced shots (crossfires) and also to assist in checking of doubles (two shots through the same hole).

Malfunctions

Should you have a malfunction the procedure is the same as that specified in the centre fire match (July 1989).

Warrnambool Pistol Club

The club was first formed on the 29th October, 1981 and the original venue was the 'H' Hall, Koroit Street, Warrnambool where air pistol was shot. This venue is still being used for air pistol and the outdoor range is located at Wickham Park, Woolsthorpe.

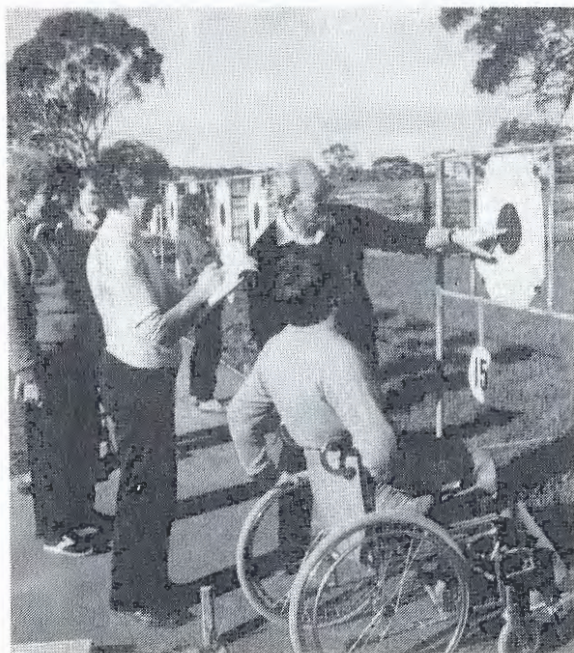
The secretary of the club, Mr. Jeff Davies informs us that the club has 40 members at present and they have just completed building a new shooting shed for the 25 metre range. In addition to this a third 25 metre range has been formed and only requires another shed for completion of same.

The club is currently approved to shot all UIT events, service pistol and action match events.

The committee of the club have been very active in obtaining government funded grants to assist them with their building and one such grant was to enable the club to build a concrete walkway on the free pistol range to permit a disabled member to use the path as a means of access to the targets (member is incapacitated and must use a wheelchair).

The writer recently attended Warrnambool Olympic Pistol Club's outdoor range and was delighted to see the amount of people who turned out for the working bee.

Anyone intending to visit Warrnambool for an open competition (fingers are crossed that it will be on soon) will be amazed with the seating accommodation on the range. It would appear that when the local picture theatre was refurbished, somehow or other all the luxury dress circle seats found their way to the range at Woolsthorpe. Obviously there were too many to have fallen off the back of a truck!
