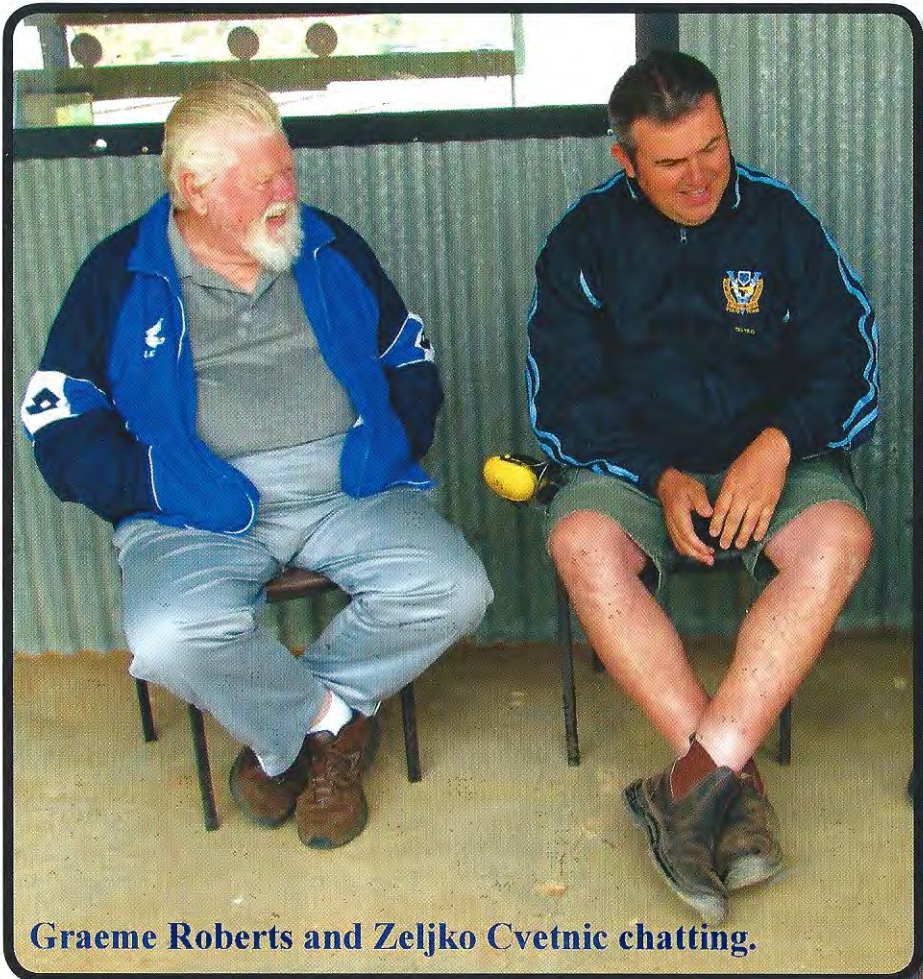

## **THOMAS RAYMOND IKIN**

### **"Tom"**

Tom and his wife Lyn had a very caring relationship, and two daughters – Wendy, and Jo, who the latter followed in her father's footsteps and made a very successful career in the Army. She is currently a serving Major.

I didn't get to meet Tom until May 1973, nearly a year after the formation of the Melton Pistol Club. Tom was a major driving force in the formation of Melton Pistol Club, but was unable in those days to be a member of more than one club at the same time. The reason being that he helped in the formation of the Watsonia Pistol Club, and was a very active member there.

Tom chose the existing site of our club, and it remains much as saw it to this day.

Tom continued to give unstinting support to the Club during it's formation and early years, even to the extent of loaning his Feinwerkbau Model 65 air pistol to the club when it shot at the Melton Football Ground on Wednesday evenings. The club's air pistols were a couple of Gecados, but the most popular was Tom's Feinwerkbau, until some mishap or other caused a breakage.

Tom continued to support everyone, until he was promoted to WOII, and transferred elsewhere. We didn't see much of Tom for some time after that.

The next we see, I am sure he was out out the Army, and standing for State elections, which were unfortunately, not successful, but he gave the winner a good run for his money.

It was about this time, that Tom was able to become a financial member of Melton, as he was no longer a member of Watsonia, and the rules too had changed by this time.

During his time in the Army, Tom had a interesting career, much of which he was unable to show. Like many other soldiers, he was sent to places (countries) where they were not supposed to be, and of course, there is no record, and he was never able to wear any decorations for this. Another was when he volunteered for Korea, and landed on a beach there, only to find that the war had finished, but not before some young men lost their lives. He had a magnificent GI issue Colt 45ACP 1911, which he literally picked up in Korea on that beach. The young officer had no further use for it or the holster. Again, because he landed after the cessation of hostilities, he was unable to wear the Korean decorations. He was told of post hostilities decorations for Korea not long before his death, but whether he was able to claim these we do not know.

Tom continued to work in many committee positions, usually on the executive side right up until the end. It was this untiring continuous support for the club, that Tom was made an Honorary Life Member of the Melton Pistol Club Inc.

# 24<sup>th</sup> International 1920 Match Pistol Australia National Championships

22<sup>nd</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup> October 2012

The Nationals this year hosted by the V. A. P. A., and conducted at the Mildura Pistol Club range. Since being granted to Nationals in December 2011, the Club has spent many hours improving their range. Peter Griffin, the Organising Secretary, has also spent a good deal of time seeking sponsors for the event.

I was involved as liaison between the V A P A Executive and the Club in addition to my Team Management role. The Club received 63 entries to these Nationals which were down a little on previous years.

The Club conducted the State Championships in August 2012, which allowed the Club to gear up for the Nationals. Apart from a problem with one of their target moving motors, the Nationals proceeded without problem.

Many shooters assisted where possible and matches ran often ahead of schedule. With the target system mounted on rails and motorised, the shooters do not have to move down range, which is excellent in wet weather.
