Entry Conditions:

Rules: I.S.S.F. rules will apply as far as practicable to matches and pistols.
Safety flags must be used.

Gun checks: Will be conducted from 7.00am each day prior to events.
Please be available at least 30 minutes prior to your first match

Shooters must produce VAPA ID, licence, current grading card and vax certificate on request. **ID cards must be worn on ranges.**

Juniors shooting both senior and junior matches will shoot only one match (one entry fee will apply) and scores will count for both matches.
Women may shoot both Centre Fire and Sport pistol if range capacity permits. Men may shoot Sport Pistol if range capacity permits.

Special Entry Conditions:

The Ballarat Pistol Club is committed to protecting the safety and wellbeing of both members and visitors. In the context of the COVID-19 pandemic, this is achieved by adhering to the Victorian Chief Health Officer Directions and the strict application of the published COVID Safe Principles.

The Ballarat Pistol Club COVID Safe requirements are aligned to the Victorian Chief Health Officer Directions and are therefore subject to change.

Should circumstances change to the extent that we are prevented from holding the ISSF Open, for example due to directions from the Chief Health Officer, the Ballarat Pistol Club will refund/return all entry money. It is therefore important that all EFT transactions are appropriately referenced.
