- **Roast Chicken & Vegetables with Gravy:** Coriander powder, cumin powder, Cajun spice, Moroccan spice, chicken breast, garlic, thyme, potato, broccoli, green beans, kale.

Meals will be ordered through a catering company. Please have entries and orders in by closing date, April 28. There will be no refunds of meals for cancellations after May 13.

25m Pistol Men (Spaces limited to 1x detail of 32 competitors)

A detail will be squadded between approx. 3pm and 4pm. You'll likely need to patch and change your own targets, and there may be a brief time that you will be shooting under lights. We will transition from Precision stage straight into the Rapid Fire stage. This applies irrelevant of whether you enter Centrefire as well or not. Does not apply to **Junior's/Women/WSPS**.

Rules: ISSF and PA rules will be followed as closely as practicable. Local range rules will also apply – **Competitors must not occupy their bays while range staff are down range. For 10m and 50m events, competitors must be on the line 25 minutes prior to the start time of the match. Set up time for these events is now 10 minutes. All 25m events now have a 3-minute preparation time.**

Entries: Will be accepted in order of receipt up to range capacity by the closing date, **Friday 28th April 2023. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Organising Secretary.**

Squadding: All competitors will be advised of their squadding via email. Please keep an eye out on your spam/junk folder. Squadding time is the commencement of the match. Preparation time will be prior to this. Competitors may be squadded to assist on ranges. **A detail of Air Pistol will be available at 7:00pm on Friday 19th.**

Juniors: Juniors entering both junior and senior events will only shoot one match (one entry fee will apply) and scores will count for both matches.

Equipment Control: Will be conducted from 5:00pm Friday and from 7:00am Saturday and Sunday.

Front Gate: Will be open from 3:00pm on Friday and from 6:00am on Saturday and Sunday, and will be closed outside these times, so please call Paul Eskaf should you need to gain access.

Trophies/Medals: Will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each grade of each event. **There won't be any aggregate trophies/medals.**

Catering: Meals and light snacks, including breakfast and drinks will be available on Saturday and Sunday. Light snacks and beverages will be available on Friday night.
