It is the start of another new year and a number of events have already taken place. It started early with a 4-day Come and Try Event for around 250 venturers at the Warragul Drouin Pistol Club, I attended the four days and had a great time.

Thank you to Aaron Hanks and all the members of the club and volunteers from other clubs who came along to help. A full report with photos is in this issue.

On the competition front, Castlemaine started the ball rolling with their Goldfields Open on 3rd—4th February. With 96 entries this year and the usual hot weather, everyone had a great time with some good scores and grade brakes shot.

Congratulations to Chelsea and Gary Mullens who organised and ran the event for the first time, job well done.

This was followed by the Action Match at Yarra, Service & WA1500 at Outtrim (which I attended on the Saturday) and Action Match at Geelong.

Our first State Titles will be ISSF State Titles to be held at Geelong between the 9th—11th March. It has been a long time since Geelong held an ISSF State Titles and the committee has been working hard with Peter Davis to get everything ready.

In between these events, some of our members have been busy competing for positions on the Olympic team for Paris this year. The first event was the BISC Cup between the 12th—14th January, four Victorians attended with:

Between the 15th—18th February, the Sydney Cup at Sydney International Shooting Centre was held. Sergei won gold in Rapid Fire and Elena winning gold in 25m Pistol Women.

Other members who competed at the event were Paul Eskaf, Damon Griffiths (both made the Rapid Fire finals), Seth Bish, Rick McGowan, Talia Woodroffe, Fiona Marcum and

Chris Yunfan Lu who came 5th in the Individual 10m Air Pistol.

There is still a long way to go before the Australian Pistol Team is selected, but it is a start.

In February, the Victorian Coaching Council held its AGM. Jack Holden and Tina Markowski have stood down as Director and Secretary after serving for 6 years.

I want to take this opportunity to thank Jack and Tina for all their tireless work and dedication to our sport over the past 6 years. This was Jack's second time as Director, he started to bring the State Teams together for training and reconnected to the coaches in the clubs, then came COVID and the lockdowns.

Tina was Jack's support, and being computer savvy, she kept people in contact and sent out information including training ideas and videos to all our coaches, as well as maintaining records of training done by coaches each month and maintaining their accreditations.

To both of you, thank you for your help and support these last 6 years and I wish you both good health for the future.

Congratulations to newly elected Director of Coaching Craig Parke,

deputy John Kearney and Secretary Karen Probst.

The Council already had their first committee meeting, we look forward to hearing what they have planned for this year and moving forward.

VAPA and the coaching council have started on a new program in partnership with the Bendigo Academy of Sport. The trial program will be centred around the Bendigo Pistol Club and involves complete training courses for juniors. If successful, it will be expanded to all regional areas around Victoria. I will give more details in the next issue.

This is the first year that the Pistol Australia National's have been split up and not held over the Easter Break.

The PA Nationals will be held at the Cessnock Pistol Club, NSW between the 9th—15th of April.

The ISSF Nationals at Brisbane International Shooting Complex, QLD between the 15th—19th May.

For further information, I will leave to our State Team Manager Cherie Blake.

There has been a lot of news in the press lately, regarding new laws in WA restricting ownership of firearms to 10 per person (some exemptions apply to sporting groups) and Tasmania where new legislation is being drafted to introduce registration requirements for antique firearms similar to operational firearms. To date, our conversations with LRD indicate no concerns about the current legislation involving handguns. As I am the VAPA representative on the Victorian Firearm Consultative Committee's Legislation and Policy Sub Committee where all new legislation and policy documents are reviewed before heading to parliament, discussions and recommendations are made by firearm stakeholders here in Victoria. This will hopefully provide warning of any changes that may affect our sport. Finally, we have stated to LRD and the government the reasons we need a handgun licence and to own handguns is for competition shooting. The grants offered by state and federal governments come with requirements. If we do not compete in

matches set down by LRD or on the international stage, or do not place on the podium or in finals, there is the likelihood that funding can be withdrawn which could lead to the withdrawal of genuine reasons for holding licences and ownership of handguns.

We need to run open competitions throughout the year, we need to encourage new members into our sport and to put in scores for the Postals, we need to attend Opens and State Titles. A number of clubs have small membership and need support— at the Castlemaine Open, members competing are asked to help where possible with RO duties, scoring and patching, so events run smoothly and finish on time. To their credit a lot of members put their hands up to help.

If your club wants to run an Open, support them by volunteering where you can, and then the membership can then support you, if we do not work together and keep our sport alive then there is no sport.

VAPA seeks volunteers

As of the 1st January 2024, Pistol Australia and therefore VAPA, have now adopted the updated National Integrity Framework and each of the five (5) integrity policies that sit within the framework, as set down by Sports Integrity Australia.

The five (5) policies are:

- a) Safeguarding Children and Young People Policy;
- b) Competition Manipulation and Sport Gambling Policy;
- c) Improper Use of Drugs and Medicine Policy;
- d) Member Protection Policy;
- e) Complaints, Disputes and Discipline Policy

As part of the new set up, all association members of PA have to appoint an Integrity Officer, that person is Aaron Hanks.

As part of this new process, the VAPA executive is asking for anyone in our association, with experience or knowledge in handling complaints or grievances either in sport or at work, who would be willing, if required to sit on a panel to resolve or give direction to the executive on any disputes or grievances undertaken by the Integrity Officer.

From 9th —12th of January 2024, Warragul Drouin Pistol Club hosted 250 Ventures for an introduction to pistol shooting.

As the Ventures were having a camp at Lardner Park, 5 km away from the club, it was organized for busses to ferry the kids from Lardner to the club.

With around 30 kids and 4 leaders attending the club twice a day, WDPC converted their refurbished 50m range into an air range allowing up to 18 kids at a time to have a try at the sport.

The club asked for volunteers from other clubs to assist with a handful of people answered the call.

Needing 15 volunteers a day to run the event, WDPC members were great in offering their time — and making up 90% of the help.

The kids attending range were aged from 14 years up to 18 with almost a 50/50 split of male and females attending. Most of the leaders had a go as well. Even the media people attending had a go!

All kids got at least 20 shots with all improving their shots with some expert assistance from their instructors. There was a lot of comparing targets after the event.

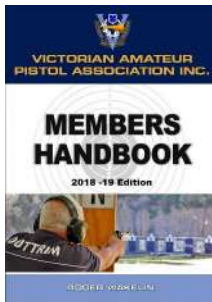

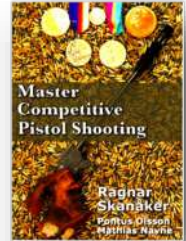

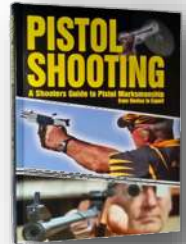
