The storage facilities meet the legislated storage requirements for handguns detailed hereunder;
Longarm licences for category C or D longarms and handgun licences
(1) The firearm must be stored in a steel safe—
(a) which is of a thickness that is not easily penetrable; and
(b) which, if it weighs less than 150 kilograms when it is empty, must be bolted to the structure of the premises where the firearm is authorised to be kept; and
(c) which, when any firearm is stored in it, is locked.
(2) If more than 15 firearms are stored on the premises where the firearm is stored, the premises must be fitted with an effective alarm system.
(3) Any ammunition for the firearm must be stored in a locked container separate from the safe in which the firearm must be stored.

## MINIMUM RECOMMENDED SPECIFICATIONS FOR A SAFE

- (i) Not less than 4.75mm (3/16") mild steel plate (thinner plate if hardened steel should be satisfactory), welded construction, suitably reinforced.
- (ii) The security of the safe shall not depend on external hinges or lock.
